ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Tuition

The price of Tuition is \$1,495.00 (one-time) or three payments of \$575 (payment plan). All students pay their own room and board at the facility of their choice. Our refund policy is that after attending our school for three days, if we feel you are not capable of becoming an auctioneer or if you are not satisfied, your tuition will be refunded. Once you have successfully completed the course you are entitled to Life Membership in the school and may attend any future course for free. (Does not include CE Courses)

Refund Policy

The Reppert School of Auctioneering shall pay a refund to the student in the amount calculated under the refund policy specified in this section. Refunds will be given no later than thirty-one days after a student's request for cancellation or withdrawal.

A full refund will be given if the enrollment agreement is canceled within five days of signing, or if there is failure to meet admission requirements. A full refund will also be granted if the enrollment was procured as a result of misrepresentation in the school's written materials, or after touring the school or attending classes the student withdraws within three days and requests a refund. Students withdrawing from the program within the first five days will be given a full refund. After attending the first five days of the school, a student is no longer entitled to a refund.

Length of Term

All school terms last ten days. This is intensive training. You will receive more training in the field of auctioneering during our 100 hour course than is available anywhere else in the world. Classes run Friday through the following Sunday. No class terms will be held during the holidays of Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Years.

Course Completion

To successfully complete the course each student must receive a passing grade average of seventy-five percent on the three, one-hundred question exams given by the school. Unless a student is excused by the school administration due to illness, death in the family, or acts of God, a student must attend seventy-five percent (seventy-five hours) of the class sessions to successfully complete the course.

Student Conduct

No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed on school premises or at any school function. The use of chewing tobacco is not allowed during class sessions. Good conduct is expected and insubordination to instructors will not be tolerated.

How the Class Schedule Works

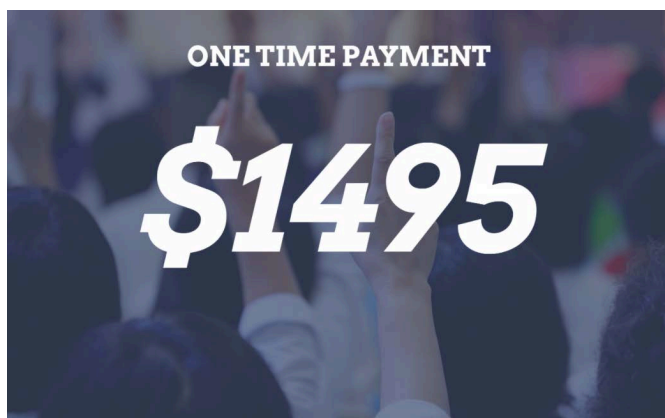
All school terms last ten days: Friday through the following Sunday. On the final day (which is graduation day), class will end early-afternoon. The class sessions last all day from

Classroom Location

Transportation

If you are flying in, the closest airport is the Fort Wayne International Airport (FWA).

Schedule

Each class is 50 minutes in length, with 50 minutes of instruction and a 10 minute break. Coffee, water and a refrigerator will be provided. During the class there will be nearly thirty instructors. Classes begin at 8:00 AM and end at 9:00 PM each day. Each Sunday, we will begin at a later start time to allow for worship. The final day will end at 4 p.m. On the first day of the course, registration will begin at 7:30 AM with class starting at 8:00 AM.

Testing

In Class Testing

During the ten days you will be given three, one hundred question, multiple choice exams. To pass the class, there must be an accumulative score of 75% on all three exams. Retakes are available.
